

REGISTRATION FOR 2026 PART B SESSION 2 COURSE AND EXAMINATIONS [RETAKERS FROM PREVIOUS SESSIONS]

1. Candidates who failed their Part B Bar Examinations in their previous attempt(s) may register to retake their failed subject(s) at Session 2 of Part B Bar Examinations 2026. Candidates retaking the Part B Bar Examinations **MUST** register and pay for **ALL** their failed subjects. To register, you must complete the registration form on page 5.
2. **The fee for retaking 1 module is \$545.00 (inclusive of GST).**
3. For applicants who are neither Singapore citizens nor permanent residents, you will require a Student's Pass to take the Part B Course and Examinations. SILE will correspond with you on the application process separately via email.

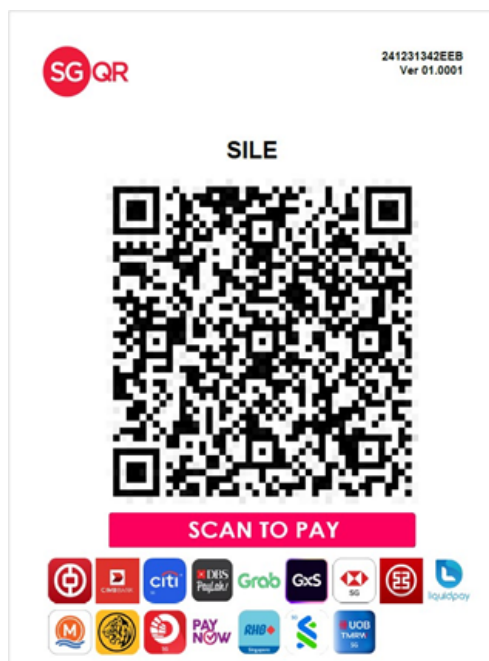

5. **Indicate “B-[FULL NAME OF APPLICANT]” in the payment details. Include as much of your full name as the space will allow. This will allow us to verify that payment has been made. The payment screenshot must show the applicant’s full name and that the transfer has been made. If we are not able to confirm your payment, you may be asked to submit additional documentary proof.**
6. You are responsible for any bank charges that may be imposed and must ensure that we receive the full amount clear of any bank charges. Paying us the wrong amount or failing to indicate your full name may cause a delay in processing. We will not process your payment unless full payment is received. If you make excess payment, you may be liable for bank / administrative charges for processing a refund.

SkillsFuture Credits (SFC)

7. All Singapore citizens aged 25 and above will be able to utilise their SFC account to pay for the Course fee.
8. If you would like to utilise your SFC, do take note of the following:
 - (a) Only **Base-Tier SFC** may be used for offsetting the B Course fee (Mid-Career Tier SFC are **NOT** eligible for claims).
 - (b) Please make payment of the B Course fee **less** the SFC amount you will be claiming. **If this figure is incorrect, the SFC authority will reject the request to utilise the SFC.**
 - (c) A screenshot of your **Base-Tier SFC** balance must be attached at the point of application submission.
 - (d) Please submit an SFC claim by logging in to <https://www.myskillsfuture.gov.sg/> **only after you have received an invoice from SILE.**
 - (e) Please note that the SFC claim window will be open from **17 May 2026 to 15 July 2026.** **Do note that late submissions will not be accepted.**
9. Please also note the following before deciding to utilise your SFC:
 - (a) If you have already made an initial self-payment for the Course in full, you will not be able to use SFC for the Course.
 - (b) SFC is not intended to pay for training provided by employers, which should continue to be borne by your employer. If you need further clarification, please write to <https://service-portal.skillsfuture.gov.sg>.

Post-Secondary Education Account (PSEA)

10. Singapore citizens who wish to use the fund from their PSEA to reimburse their Course and Examinations fees may do so from **15 July 2026 to 4 August 2026**. More details will be announced on SILE Campus closer to the PSEA application date.

2026 PART B SESSION 2 COURSE AND EXAMINATIONS - REGISTRATION GUIDE

SILE will accept registrations for the 2026 Part B Session 2 Course and Examinations from **1 to 30 April 2026 (5pm)**.

- A. Read this Registration Guide carefully.
- B. Fill in the Registration Form found on page 5.
- C. Submit the Registration Form along with a screenshot of your payment via email to partb.application@sile.edu.sg **by 5pm on Thursday, 30 April 2026**.
- D. SILE will notify you of the registration outcome by **1 July 2026**.

Part B Course information

1. The Part B Course will take place from **15 July 2026 to 16 November 2026**.
2. You should receive an email from SILE by **8 July 2026**, which will include the login credentials to SILE Campus, and details regarding the Part B Course and Examinations.
3. In addition, you should receive an email with your LawNet login credentials **by 15 July 2026** from Noreply@lawnet.sg.

Withdrawal policy

4. You must submit any other documents and provide any information that may be required by SILE. SILE reserves the right to treat your application as withdrawn if you fail to submit the required documents or provide the information required within the specified deadlines.
5. If you wish to withdraw from the Course and Examinations, you must first write in to SILE as follows:

6. Any refund granted shall be in SILE's sole discretion. Please take note of the following timelines:-
 - a. If you withdraw your candidature **on or before 1 July 2026** or if your candidature is deemed withdrawn due to reasons including (but not limited to), (a) non-payment of fees; (b) failure to submit the required documents; or (c) failure to obtain the necessary exemption, **you will be eligible for a refund of the Course and Examinations fees, less the withdrawal fee of S\$545 (inclusive of GST)**.
 - b. If you withdraw your candidature **after 1 July 2026 but on or before 31 August 2026**, you may be eligible for a **partial refund of the Course and/or Examinations fees**, less the withdrawal fee of **S\$545 (inclusive of GST)**. The amount refunded, if any, will depend on the fees paid and the timing of the withdrawal. The final refund amount will be determined by SILE in its sole discretion.
 - c. **No refund will be given if you withdraw your candidature after 31 August 2026.**

Request for special arrangements

7. If you require any special arrangement during the Part B Examinations due to existing medical and/or other conditions, you must make a formal request by writing in to SILE by **31 August 2026** as follows:

8. The request must:
- (a) State clearly the medical condition and the accommodations required during the Examinations, e.g., how much extra time needed;
 - (b) Be supported by recent and relevant certification by a **Singapore registered medical specialist** who is recognised by the Singapore Medical Council. The certification should be made within 6 months before the commencement of the Examinations; and
 - (c) Include details, as well as supporting documents, of previous accommodation(s) given to you by an institution of higher learning or other examination board.
9. Certification may be rejected if it is deemed irrelevant, inadequate, or not recognised. SILE may require you to attend a medical review by a medical specialist appointed by SILE. You will have to bear the costs of such a medical review, and consent to SILE receiving a medical report from the medical specialist on your condition. In granting you accommodations, SILE may impose any conditions as it deems appropriate, and you may be required to bear the costs of any special arrangements extended to you.
10. Disciplinary action will be taken against candidates found violating any of the rules in this Guide. Candidates found in breach of any rule may be barred from sitting for the Examinations.
11. SILE reserves the right to amend the rules or impose additional rules for the conduct of the Course.
